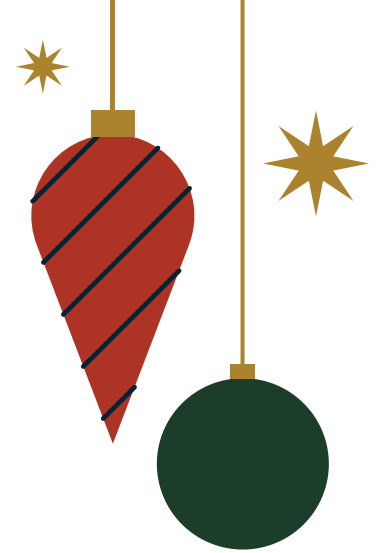
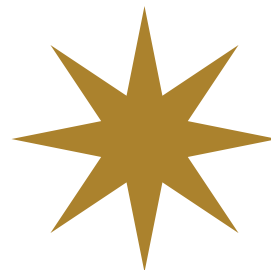

Climb aboard the fire truck for a ride around town, lights, and sirens by our local fire fighters.

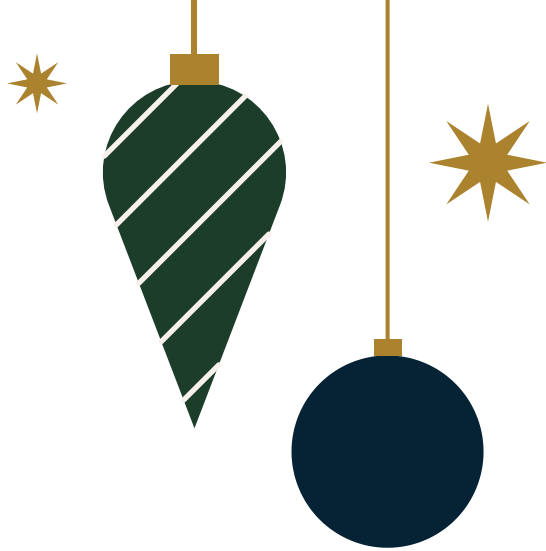
