Dear Birchwood Residents,

The Village of Birchwood is replacing our older water meters with new “smart meters.” Smart meters measure water usage more accurately and detect continuous flow events (leaks) in a timely manner.

Why the change?

- Old meters lose accuracy over time.
- Remote reads will save time during quarterly billing and reduce costs for the Village.

What it means for you

- More accurate water usage and billing process.
- Faster leak detection to save water and money.
- A more efficient and modern water system that benefits all residents.

We will notify each household before installation. Our Public Works department will complete the installation as quickly as possible with minimal disruptions.

Installation must be completed by August 31st, 2026.
